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OUR MISSION

“Empowering and developing Tamil youth through advocacy, partnership, education, assistance, and research.” CanTYD, established in 1998, is a non-profit organization dedicated to promoting excellence in Tamil youth. Our services cater to over 200,000 members of the Tamil community in the Greater Toronto Area.

OUR OBJECTIVES

- To empower and recognize the voice, achievements, and vision of young people
- To provide role models for Tamil youth
- To encourage Tamil youth to aspire towards higher education in order to motivate further vocational and career options
- To assist immigrant youth with integration into Canadian society
- To curb Tamil youth violence by addressing the root causes

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APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

To apply for the awards, applicants must:

- Be of Tamil descent
- Be enrolled as a full time high school student in the Greater Toronto Area or surrounding areas
- Winners **MUST** be able to attend Awards of Excellence, Sunday October 29th, 2017.

AWARD RECIPIENTS

- All award winners will be recognized on stage at the Awards of Excellence Gala
- Each applicant is eligible to win only one (1) award
- Grade 9 winners will receive a \$50 prize
- Grade 10 winners will receive a \$100 prize
- Grade 11 winners will receive a \$150 prize

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Scholarships of up to \$1000 are available only to Grade 12 award winners.

To be eligible, all grade 12 applicants must:

- Be in their final year of high school, receive their Ontario Secondary School diploma (OSSD) at the end of term, and have completed all of its requirements by the application due date (June 30th, 2017).
- Grade 12 students applying for the *Academic Achievement Award* **must** be attending a post-secondary institution (college or university) in September 2017.
- Students attending post- secondary institutions must submit a copy of their acceptance letter from the institution along with the application.
- CanTYD aims to be inclusive of all pathways to excellence that are available for our youth today. We recognize and encourage the growth of the Youth in the Tamil Community and the dynamic opportunities that are available to them. Students are not required to attend a post-secondary institution to receive a scholarship from CanTYD, however, will need to provide an explanation as to what they will do with the scholarship money when submitting the application.



AWARD CATEGORIES

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

- Recognizes students who have performed exceptionally in their academic career
- At least one of the required references must be from a teacher
- Applicants must have a minimum average of 85%
- In this category up to four awards may be distributed, one per grade.

ATHLETIC ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

- Recognizes students who have achieved high standards in athleticism and/or excellence in sportsmanship in school or outside of school
- Applicants should exhibit both leadership and sportsmanship in their athletic activities
- In this category up to four awards may be distributed
 - **Junior Category:** one male and one female may be awarded from Grades 9 and 10
 - **Senior Category:** one male and one female may be awarded from Grades 11 and 12

MOST IMPROVED STUDENT AWARD

- Recognizes students who have demonstrated a significant improvement within their academics, leadership abilities, confidence and/or personal development.
- At least one of the required references must be from a teacher
- One award may be distributed for this category

OUTSTANDING COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTION AWARD

- Recognizes students who have made significant contributions towards improving both community and school life
- In this category up to four awards may be distributed, one per grade.

PERFORMING/VISUAL ARTS AWARD

- Recognizes students who have demonstrated outstanding creative ability in the performing and visual arts
- In this category up to four awards may be distributed, one per grade.
- Please refer to **Table 1** below for application requirements



Table 1. Requirements for Performing/Visual Arts Award Category

Award category	Requirements
Visual Arts	A portfolio consisting of 3 – 5 pieces (drawings / sketches, paintings, sculptures, etc.): each piece must be titled and include a description (maximum of 10 sentences)
Dance, Instrumental, and Vocal music	Submit videos of two performances from two different events (performances recorded specifically for this purpose will also be accepted); the dance performance should depict both technical and artistic expression aspects of dance
Drama	Submit videos of two performances (each limited to 15 min): ONE performance of choice and ONE monologue (demonstrating creativity); a description (maximum of 10 sentences) is also required for each performance

MULTIMEDIA/CREATIVE WRITING AWARD

- Recognizes students who have demonstrated originality and creativity within the field of multimedia and expressive writing
- One award may be distributed for this category

MULTIMEDIA

- Recognizes students who have demonstrated originality within the field of multimedia, such as graphics, photography, website creations, videography, documentaries etc.
- Applicant must create a work piece focusing on Mental Health Awareness
- One award may be distributed for this category
- Please refer to **Table 2** for application requirements

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Table 2. Requirements for Multimedia Award Category

Award category	Requirements
Photography	Submit a portfolio consisting of 5-7 pieces. Each piece must include a title and description (Maximum of 5 sentences).
Website Creation and Graphic Designer	Submit 1-2 pieces. Each piece must include a title and description (Maximum of 10 sentences).
Documentary and Videography	Submit 1-2 videos. Each piece must include a title and description (Maximum of 10 sentences).

CREATIVE WRITING

- Creative Writing includes slam poetry, poetry, blogs, short stories, screen-writing, journalism, novels, songwriting etc.
- Applicants of poetry, short story, journalism and songwriting: 2-3 pieces. Each piece must include a title and description (5 sentences maximum).
- Applicants of blogs, screen writing and novels: 1-2 pieces. Each piece must include a title and description (10 sentences maximum)
- In addition, you must provide a work piece with a focus on Mental Health Awareness.

YOUNG ENTREPRENEUR AWARD

- Recognizes students in self-start up ventures and/or small businesses by the student
- Must have proof of business and/or business portfolio (schemes, plans, mandates, etc.)
- A pitch for why this business should be funded (can send proposal or PowerPoint presentation) is required
- Two awards may be distributed with a bursary for the business, one male and one female
- This category also comes with a possible internship opportunity. Internship opportunities will be determined based on availability.

References can be from teachers, employers, guidance counselors, and volunteer or community organizations. Please ensure that letters are on appropriate letterhead and include the signature of the referee.

Athletic Achievement Award:

1. What are some difficulties you faced when balancing your academic and athletic career in high school? How did you overcome these difficulties OR how did these difficulties hinder your athletic career, and what did you do to move forward?
2. Do you see any bias in sports when it comes to male and female athletes? What are these biases and what can be done to change or overcome them?
3. How has pursuing athletics affected or changed your life in any way? Why was this important to you?

Most Improved Student Award:

1. What are some steps you took to improve yourself in the last year? How have these steps helped you grow, and what are you doing to keep growing?
2. What is one tip you would give to someone who may be struggling and wishes to take a step toward improving themselves? Explain why.



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3. Pick one (1) motivational quote and explain why it is important to you. How does it relate to your life and why is it important?

Outstanding Community Contribution Award:

1. Why do you think it is important to work with and give back to your community? How have you done so in your personal life?
2. Define community. What does community mean to you? Why is it important for individuals to contribute to their communities?
3. “We make a living by what we get, but we make a life by what we give”. Explain this quote using your own personal life experiences.

Performing/Visual Arts Award:

1. What creative medium would you like to pursue that you have not yet? How will this medium help share your creativity and/or story with the world?
2. How do you wish to affect your audience through your music, dramatics or artwork? What do you wish to convey when you perform in front of a crowd or present your artwork to an audience?
3. What are ways performing and visual arts work to convey larger societal or political ideas? Explain how you think two diverse concepts can work together to produce a strong impact on the audience.

Multimedia/Creative Writing Award

Multimedia

1. How have you used a multimedia platform as a tool to express your identity as a Tamil youth?
2. Pick a creative tool you use and describe the process of how you create your work.
3. How has technology impacted your creativity? Describes the benefits and limitations.

Creative Writing

1. Where do you draw influence from to produce a written piece? How have events in your life or your surroundings affected your writing?
2. Why do you choose to write? Explain.
3. If you were given a choice of having anything you want to improve the field of creative writing, what would you choose and why? You may wish to touch on what you have struggled with and how this choice could help you.

Young Entrepreneurship Award

1. Do you think entrepreneurial skills are learned or inherited?
2. What qualities make for a successful leader, and why? Be sure to provide an example of a leader or entrepreneur that inspired you.
3. Discuss the following quote, “It’s fine to celebrate success, but it is more important to heed the lessons of failure.” – Bill Gates.
